About Us

The Mystic Grove is the UU Pagan affinity group (study group) that is affiliated with the First Unitarian Church of Orlando. It was organized in 2001 for the purpose of creating a Pagan community within the framework of Unitarian Universalism. To achieve that purpose, the Mystic Grove focuses on the areas of education, worship, service, and fellowship.

In June 2016, we became a Covenant of Unitarian Universalist Pagans (CUUPS) chapter.

We have no "official group path." We encourage members to find their own Pagan path. Rituals are volunteer led and the volunteer may choose to do the ritual in the style of their Pagan path.
